PROPOSED REMEDIES TO ADDRESS THE SEGREGATION LAWSUIT

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- A). The creation of (21) county-wide regional school districts, governed by an eleven (11) member school board* (Intra-school governance protocols must be established)
- B). The establishment of state mandated high quality pre-schools for all eligible youth
- C). Within all county-wide regional school districts there would be theme related academic programs (commencing with the sixth grade)
- D). Existing public county Vocational Schools would be required to diversify their enrollment (by region and municipalities)
- E). Provide county-wide regional school districts with adequate mental health resources
- F). School districts should promote a culturally relevant pedagogy
- G). The State Department of Education would create a monetary plan for “school districts”. The funds would provide additional revenue for per pupil expenditures, busing, curriculum development (including a mandated Pre-K- 12th grade diversity curriculum), facilities maintenance and increased salaries for teachers and support staff, etc.

*Under the State mandate, each county (21) would establish specific regions in order to determine the distribution of elective membership on the regional school boards.
